Eradicating slavery, eliminating human trafficking.

Parker Drilling is committed to respecting human rights as laid out in the UNITED NATIONS UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS, including the abolition of forced, compulsory labor and all forms of child labor, and the elimination of discrimination in employment or occupation. We support efforts by governments around the world to take action to eliminate human trafficking within their borders and in modern-day supply chains. In the fight against slave labor, Parker Drilling fully supports the United Kingdom's efforts to eradicate modern slavery in all forms, including servitude, forced and compulsory labor and human trafficking and all other human rights violations as described in the MODERN SLAVERY ACT 2015 as enacted by the Parliament of the United Kingdom. We stand with the UK government and all other governments around the world that seek to abolish child labor, eradicate slavery and eliminate all forms of forced or compulsory labor and indentured servitude. Parker Drilling's Supply Chain Management team works with suppliers that respect human rights. Parker Drilling will not work with suppliers engaged in human rights abuses or that use any form of forced, involuntary or compulsory labor or suppliers that engage in child labor. At Parker Drilling, we will continue to strengthen our Supply Chain Management processes and supplier relationships to ensure the integrity of our supply chain, including expectations to our suppliers to eliminate modern slavery.
